### Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme

Established by the Research Grants Council (RGC) since 2009, the "Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme" aims to recruit talented students from around the world to undertake PhD studies in Hong Kong. The Fellowship provides the following for each awardee for three years:

- a yearly stipend of US\$42,460 (~ HK\$331,200); and
- conference and research related travel allowance of US\$1,760 (~HK\$13,800) per year

In addition, CityU will award each successful Fellowship recipient a *Scholarship*, which covers students' tuition and on-campus hostel accommodation fees in their first year of research studies and provide a full stipend to support the fourth year of PhD study. Various types of financial support will be provided to eligible students to undertake research related activities and to attend international academic conferences.

# Application Procedures and Deadlines

#### Step One

Applicants should first submit an initial application at the RGC's Online Application System (OAS) at and obtain a RGC reference number on or before RGC's deadline (i.e. 1 December 2023, 12:00 noon Hong Kong Time)

#### Step Two

Applicants are then required to submit full application, together with supporting documents, ...... to CityU's Online Admission System at https://cerg1.ugc.edu.hk/hkpfs/apply.html, https://www.cityu.edu.hk/pg/hong-kong-phd-fell owship-scheme, and quote the RGC reference number, before CityU's deadline (i.e. 1 December 2023, 11:59 pm Hong Kong Time)

Short-listed candidates will be invited for an admission interview. Application results will be announced in April/May 2024.
